Brief Explanation:

The Board President's Scholarship Award is presented annually by the President of the Board of Education, California Coast Credit Union, and Mission Federal Credit Union to four monthly classified employees interested in becoming teachers. Each year both California Coast Credit Union and Mission Federal Credit Union donate \$2,000 each to fund these scholarships.

The recipients of the scholarships will each receive a \$1,000 check that will be presented at the November 18, 2014, Board of Education meeting. Scholarship funds are to be used for tuition, fees, or books at any local two- or four-year accredited college or university. Previous winners are not eligible.

Please make this information available to monthly classified employees assigned to your site. Each applicant must submit one Application form, one Essay, and two Applicant Reference forms.
