Brief Explanation:

This circular applies to district high school students who wish to re-take a failed course in San Diego Community College District adult education courses after the regular high school day. It does not apply to regular Adult School students.

The San Diego Community College District (SDCCD) Continuing Education courses shown below are approved for the 2014-15 school year for transfer credit toward a San Diego Unified School District (SDUSD) high school diploma. Some classes will be conducted in a learning center format; others will be carried out in a formal classroom setting on a 9- or 10-week schedule.

¹ Effective with the 2012-13 school year, Adult School course numbers were changed because these courses are not exactly equivalent to regular high school courses. (This applies to district adult education courses as well as Community College adult education courses.) As a result, *these courses no longer qualify to meet a-g requirements*. Regular Adult School students who are college bound must enroll in a community college before transferring to a four-year college/university.
