School Counselors of the Year	Levels/Departments: Elementary (1 Counselor) Middle (1 Counselor) High School (1 Counselor) Resource Counselor (1 Counselor) *Note: K-8 counselors may be nominated under elementary or middle school levels.	Principals, department heads, or staff should work with their sites/departments to select a School Counselor of the Year.
Rookie School Counselor of the Year	Counselor must be new to the school counseling profession; within the last 2 years	Principals, department heads, or staff should work with their sites/departments to select a Rookie School Counselor of the Year.
Counseling Fieldwork Student of the Year	Fieldwork student must have experience in the current academic year to be eligible.	Principals, department heads, or staff should work with their sites/departments to select a Fieldwork Student of the Year.

Selection Process:

A selection committee consisting of Counseling and Guidance Governance Team subcommittee members and program managers will evaluate all nominations submitted. The committee will evaluate all nominations within the context of the selection criteria which are organized around three themes:

School Counseling Program Community Involvement Leadership and Commitment Distance Learning

The selection committee will recommend the finalists for the outlined award categories. There is no appeal process.
