Brief Explanation:

The Elementary/Middle School Pathway to Biliteracy Awards are awards granted to students in Kindergarten, 5th and 8th grade certifying that they are in the process of achieving mastery of two or more languages. The Pathway Award is directly linked to the Language Learning Policy adopted by the San Diego Unified School District Board of Trustees in August, 2009, which recognizes that "in addition to being academically prepared and fully proficient in English, all students benefit from being proficient in another language". In addition, attainment of the Pathway Award clearly advances tenets of the District's Vision 2020 and The CA Education for a Global Economy Initiative by "preparing our students for the competitive global economy they will face in the years ahead" and the Vision 2020 goal to ensure that "students from all backgrounds in our district develop the ability to communicate in two languages." Qualifying 5th and 8th grade students receive the Elementary/Middle School Pathway to Biliteracy Awards. All Kindergarten students enrolled in Biliteracy/Dual Language programs receive the Kindergarten Commitment to Biliteracy Certificate.
