



As a system we have set goals across all schools to improve outcomes for ALL learners focusing on Students With Disabilities and English Learners.






Actualizing Integrated Teaching & Learning Opportunity for English Learners and Students With Disabilities








Graduation Rates for English Learners from the CA Dashboard



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District Total Number of Students With Individualized Education Programs








CA Dashboard Data: Graduation Rates for Students With Disabilities
