	<b>Irrigation</b> : Do not over water, and repair areas with standing water		<b>Shrubs</b> : Trim and thin shrubs and bushy plants where mosquitoes tend to hide

	<b>Machinery</b> : Cover and clean any areas that may hold water			
	<b>Playground</b> : Drill drainage holes in tire swings and playground equipment that holds water		<b>BTI</b> : A natural bacteria that kills mosquito and fly larvae, but will not hurt animals. It can be put into standing water to prevent development of larvae. Available in hardware and garden stores.	
	<b>Pools/spas</b> : Drain, cover, or stock mosquito fish in unused pools and spas
